

1st & 2nd Term Drop Off & Pickup Information

For 1st Term, **drop-off** will be on Friday, June 4th. For 2nd Term it will be on Friday, July 9th. Your drop off shift was emailed to you. If there is a major conflict, call our office and let's talk about it or email us at info@waldemar.com. Out-of-state campers, please see the note below.

If you are traveling by plane, you may fly into the San Antonio Airport by 2:00 p.m. to catch the Waldemar bus to camp as in previous years. As soon as you book your camper's flight, please email Robin@waldemar.com with your arrival details as this will dictate when the bus leaves the airport to camp.

Once again, we ask that in the week leading up to camp, you and your camper be extra careful; skip the high-risk extracurriculars (like end of year parties, etc.), and stay outdoors whenever possible. Upon arrival to camp, we will require a copy of every camper's negative test results taken within the previous 72 hours.

There are a couple of organizations who have offered reliable testing to campers and staff who live in the big cities like Dallas, Houston, Austin and SA. and they will send us the results pre-camp if that's easier for you. We'll be sending more info on that later.

As for quarantining after the test, we know many campers will be in school up to the beginning of camp for 1st Term. Schools have many protocols and safeguards in place that help us feel comfortable with the girls coming straight to camp from school. Please check your temperature for those three days before camp, and wait let us know if you're running a fever. We'll try to work something out.

Unfortunately it won't be the full-on closing like we are all used to. After the girls receive their awards and the Plaque is announced, it will be a drive through parent pick up. Pick up shifts will be by grade (for both long terms), see below for your shift:

4th & 5th Grade: 10:30 a.m.

6th & 7th Grade: 11:00 a.m.

8th & 9th Grade: 11:30 a.m.

10th & *11th Grade: 12:00 p.m.

** Hilltopper parents will be invited to IWG on Friday night.*

If you have campers in different grades, you may pick them up at the earliest time slot (i.e. you have a 5th grader and 9th grader, you may pick them both up at 10:30 a.m.) Please email info@waldemar.com if you have a conflict.

Lastly, camper drop-off is new to us so Short Term arrival will be very telling. If we see the opportunity to make the process run more smoothly, small adjustments could be made to your shift. THANK YOU in advance for your flexibility this summer as we navigate through new programming.
